ALSACE pinot blanc is often a great buy if your tastes run to French white wines. From one of the great producers, this example has a little bottle age to help it along. Subtle, lightly honeyed aromas of pear, spice and savoury earthy notes lead through a tasty palate of excellent texture. (12.5 per cent alcohol; cork.)
